ORDER

The Court orders that -

1. You, James Lokes shall file all relevant affidavits stating your

Authtority to arbitrarily search passengers cargoes at Momote Airport without a Search Warrant or Court order.

- 2. Such affidavits must be filed and served at the National Court Registry at Waigani by Friday 6 August 2010.
- 3. Until this case is finally determined, you are restrained from arbitrarily searching any passenger's cargoes without a Search Warrant, Court order or the consent of the passengers.
- 4. Until the final determination of this case, your employer shall relocate you from Momote Airport to another location of employment in Manus forthwith.
- 5. Any Manus person having been affected by the conduct of the said James Lokes in the past may file an affidavit relating to any past incident of similar conduct by the said James Lokes.
- 6. In the event that any of these orders if breached, the said James Lokes shall be arrested forthwith for contampt of court and be punished accordingly.
